



TEST OF INTERRUPTIBLE HEATING (DUEL FUEL) SET FOR NOVEMBER 18

Please be advised that the Winter Preparedness Test for Interruptible Heat (Dual Fuel) members is scheduled for Wednesday, November 18. This load control test is performed in advance of the winter Full Load Control season to ensure member familiarity with the control sequence and to ensure that backup heating systems have been validated for proper function.

During the test, residential Interruptible Heat load classes (2, 2W, & 4B) will be controlled as follows:

Time	Control Status
5:00 p.m.	Control start
5:05 p.m.	All loads interrupted (2,2W,4B)
8:30 p.m.	Class 4B loads restored
9:00 p.m.	Class 2 and 2W loads begin diversified restoral
10:00 p.m.	Class 2 and 2W loads fully restored
